DESIGNER: JOSEF FRANK

In 1925, Josef Frank founded the interior firm Haus und Garten together with his architect colleagues Oskar Wlach and Walther Sobotka. The premises were located one block from the Opera House in central Vienna, and despite difficult times, the business achieved great success. The range mainly consisted of furniture, lamps, patterned fabrics, and rugs; designs created mainly, but not exclusively, by Josef Frank.

Through display models in the store and catalogues, customers could see and order the products.

It is in such catalogues, preserved in Svenskt Tenn's archive, that the prototype for the Klöver Table was found. It has many of the typical details for Josef Frank, such as the clover-shaped table surface with inlays, the slightly curved legs, and the sleek elegance of the design. The piece was auctioned in Vienna by Svenskt Tenn to be recreated for the 100th anniversary in 2024.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Svenskt Tenn's furniture is made from wood that is varnished or coated. Clean with a soft cloth dampened with mild dish detergent or soapy water. Dry with a soft cloth. Do not expose the furniture to prolonged humidity or direct heat or use polish, oil or abrasive cleaners on the furniture.

At first, don't place objects such as vases, books and coasters on the table since this can lead to changes in colour of the surface. After that, avoid allowing objects to remain too long in the same place on the table since this might lead to darkening of the wood. In addition, avoid exposing the furniture to major changes in temperature and humidity.

Contact a furniture restorer if the coating or wood gets damaged, as it can get worse if not tended to.
