



COFFEE TABLE 2139

JOSEF FRANK WAS FOND OF the round shape. It is seen in many of his designs, both the windows in his architectural works and in the many mirrors. Coffee table 2139 combines the round shape with Josef Frank's typical comings. It was characteristic of Josef Frank to mix different materials and by making the table top in Elmroot and the rim and legs in walnut, he wanted to create a vivid expression. Coffee table 2139 was designed for Svenska Tenn in 1952.

MATERIAL Legs in lathed walnut and table rim in molded walnut. Tabletop of elm burl (root) veneer. Each table top has its individual character.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS Svenskt Tenn's furniture is made from wood and then lacquered. The woodwork should be cleaned simply with a soft cloth dampened with mild dish detergent or soapy water. Make sure to dry it with a soft cloth.

Polish, oil or abrasive cleaners should never be used on the furniture. Never expose the furniture to prolonged humidity or direct heat. If an injury in the paint or wood occurs, you should immediately contact a furniture restorer. Often you can restore easier damage, but the damage is likely to worsen if not taken care of. Never move the furniture by dragging it across the floor.

The furniture lacquer can be damaged by direct heat and lengthy exposure to dampness. Keep in mind that water-filled vases can cause condensation.

Colour variations can occur if parts of the tabletop or other wood surfaces on furniture are covered early on with, for example, books or other items. It is therefore recommended that you not put vases or placemats and the like, on the tabletop for some time when the furniture is new. This will enable the wood to age evenly over a period of time. Avoid exposing your furniture to large changes in temperature and humidity, which can significantly affect natural movements of the wood.
