

# FOLDING-TABLE 1133

DESIGNER: JOSEF FRANK, 1940s

Folding-table 1133 was designed by Josef Frank during the later half of the 1940s. The organic and kidney-shaped tabletop with its turned shape and retractable flaps facilitates human needs regarding storage surfaces and comfort. With its shape, it works well as a side table to armchairs and sofas.

## CARE INSTRUCTIONS

Svenskt Tenn's furniture is made from wood that is varnished or coated. Clean with a soft cloth dampened with mild dish detergent or soapy water. Dry with a soft cloth. Do not expose the furniture to prolonged humidity or direct heat or use polish, oil or abrasive cleaners on the furniture.

At first, don't place objects such as vases, books and coasters on the table since this can lead to changes in colour of the surface. After that, avoid allowing objects to remain too long in the same place on the table since this might lead to darkening of the wood. In addition, avoid exposing the furniture to major changes in temperature and humidity.

Contact a furniture restorer if the coating or wood gets damaged, as it can get worse if not tended to.
