



## COUCH 775

**IN THE 1930S** THE daybed, or couch, was a common feature in modern interiors. Many designers of the time focused on rest and relaxation in the home. Couch 775 was designed by Josef Frank in 1938.

# COUCH 775

**MATERIAL** Wooden frame. No-sag spring base, stuffed with foam rubber/polyether and synthetic batting. Synthetic fibre/feather cushion in downproof cases with removable fabric covers. Globe-shaped legs in stained beech.

**CARE INSTRUCTIONS** Feather cushions are sewn in three sections and uniquely assembled to provide the best possible seating comfort. All types of feather cushions need to be puffed up to maintain their resilience. Shake and puff up the cushions regularly and knead them to loosen up any feather bunches.

The legs are screwed on and may need to be tightened from time to time. For additional protection we recommend ordering extra covers for the armrests. Svenskt Tenn also offers stain guarding for further protection.
