SOFA 136 WAS DESIGNER by Björn Trägårdh for Svenskt Tenn's early furniture range and is, among other things, depicted in the company's very first furniture catalogue from 1931. The sofa's rounded corners and removable back cushions following the same shape, distinguish the design, which was very unusual for sofas in the early 1930s.

MATERIAL Wodden frame. Core of coil springs on a nosag spring base, stuffed with foam polyether.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS Feather cushions are sewn in three sections and uniquely assembled to provide the best possible seating comfort. All types of feather cushions need to be puffed up to maintain their resilience. Shake and puff up the cushions regularly and knead them to loosen up any feather bunches.

The legs are screwed on and may need to be tightened from time to time. For additional protection we recommend ordering extra covers for the armrests. Svenskt Tenn also offers stain guarding for further protection.
