



CHAIR 300

JOSEF FRANK WAS INSPIRED by the ancient Greek Klismos chair when he designed Chair 300. This type of chair arrived in Sweden in the late 1700s and can be found at Gustaf III's Haga Castle, among other places. Josef Frank's version was designed in 1925.

MATERIAL Beech/Walnut.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS Svenskt Tenn's furniture is made from wood that is varnished or coated. Clean with a soft cloth dampened with mild dish detergent or soapy water. Dry with a soft cloth. Do not expose the furniture to prolonged humidity or direct heat or use polish, oil or abrasive cleaners on the furniture.

Contact a furniture restorer if the coating or wood gets damaged, as it can get worse if not tended to.
