



CHAIR 970

CHAIR 970 WAS DESIGNED BY Josef Frank in the 1920s for the Haus und Garten (House and Garden) company and was produced by Svenskt Tenn in 1938. In 1968, the chair was displayed in mahogany with a woven rattan seat at the Nationalmuseum's Josef Frank retrospective. Now the chair is being produced in mahogany with a leather seat.

CHAIR 970

MATERIAL Frame of mahogany with mahogany pegs in the back. Tensioned fabric or leather with carrier web underneath. Cushion padded with foam, stitched with piping.

CARE INSTRUCTIONS Svenskt Tenn's furniture is made from wood that is varnished or coated. Clean with a soft cloth dampened with mild dish detergent or soapy water. Dry with a soft cloth. Do not expose the furniture to prolonged humidity or direct heat or use polish, oil or abrasive cleaners on the furniture.

Contact a furniture restorer if the coating or wood gets damaged, as it can get worse if not tended to.

Never place the chair with leather seat closer than 20-30 cm to a radiator or in direct sunlight. Vacuum clean leather often with a soft brush and, when necessary, clean any exposed surfaces. For stains that are water-soluble, dampen the area and dry using a paper towel. Never use strong solvents or chemicals. Leather is a living material that matures beautifully if treated properly.
